

Strategic Plan for 2014-2019



1) Curricular Aspects

- a) Introduction of ICT based teaching in the institution.

Considering the modern developments in teaching-learning, it was decided that learner-centric teaching methodologies be introduced in the College.

- b) Feedback on curriculum to be introduced.

Since the syllabi were revised in 2014-2015, it was decided to introduce feedback on curriculum from stakeholders.

- c) Introduction of Certificate /Add on /Value Added Courses:

To enhance employability and life skills, to cater to market requirements, to be abreast Of recent developments in their respective fields and for entrepreneurship, it was decided that the above courses be introduced.

2) Teaching Learning and Evaluation

- a) Preparation of Annual Calendar of the Institution:

The IQAC has suggested preparation of Annual Calendar of each department and various Committees, which would be compiled to form the Common Annual Calendar.

- b) Introduction of Internal Academic Audit:

Parallel Heads to be appointed to check documentation maintained in each other's Departments and give suggestions for improvements.

- c) Students to be encouraged to participate in seminars and conferences, present papers and publish them in conference proceedings and journals.

- d) The Departments to be encouraged to focus on co-curricular, extra-curricular and extension activities.

- e) Systematization of mentoring of the students.

- f) LCD projectors and smart class rooms be introduced.



3) Research

- a) It was decided that teachers be motivated to apply for Faculty Development Programmes, i.e. Orientation programme, Refresher courses and Short Term courses.
- b) Teachers to be encouraged to do their research availing of UGC schemes like the FIP (Faculty Improvement Programme) for Teacher Fellowship.
- c) Teachers to be encouraged to write and published their research in journals and conference proceedings.

4) Infrastructure and Learning Resources

- a) Apply for General Development Assistance Grants from various agencies.
- b) Introduction of new schemes for students and teachers like N- list and e- books membership in the library.
- c) Purchase of equipments and instruments for the science laboratories as per the new syllabi requirements.
- d) Renovation of the laboratories and office.
- e) Purchase of new computers.

5) Student support and progression

- a) Introduction of Bridge courses.
- b) Strengthen Alumni Association of the institution.
- c) Increase facilities/schemes for students.

6) Governance, Leadership and Management

- a) Provision of budget for participation in seminars and conferences.
- b) Introduction of ICT in administration.
- c) Introduction of external academic and administrative audit.
- d) Introduction of quality audit like ISO Audit and AAA.
